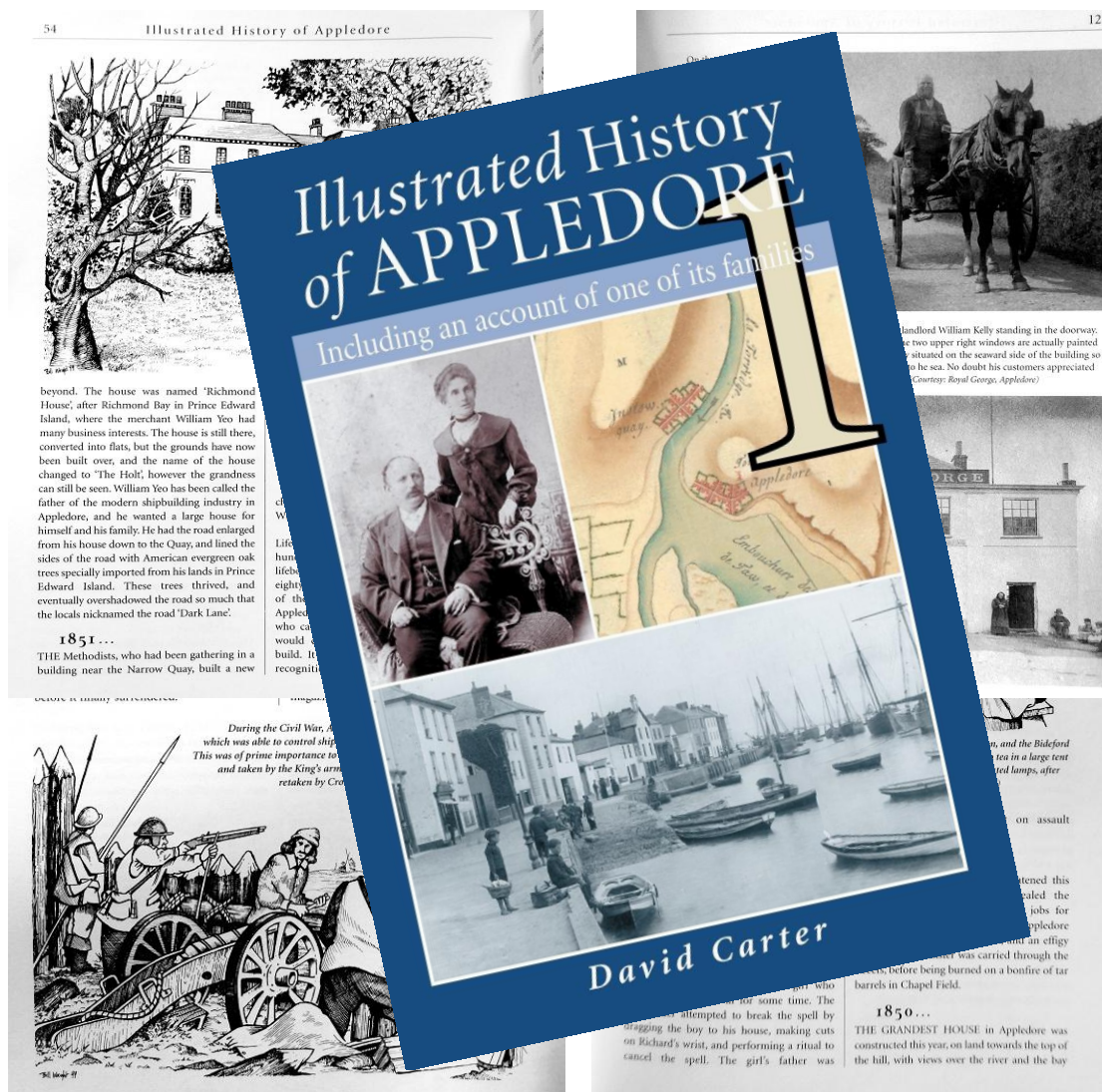


Illustrated History of Appledore

Book 1



David Carter's first book of Appledore's history includes many old photographs of the village, and a history of the ship-owning Slade family.

This book started out as being the 'definitive' history of Appledore, but when sufficient information for books 2 and 3 was found, it became obvious that Appledore had far more history than anyone realised. Nevertheless, this is a good stand-alone history and a starting point for anyone interested in this maritime village.

It includes many 'before and after' pictures of the village comparing today's views with a variety of old photographs. This is accompanied by a brief history of the village, and about 300 old photographs and drawings by Bill Wright. Finally, there is a family history of the ship-owning Slade family, and the accounts of some of the vessels which they owned and traded from Appledore.
