**THE WILL OF WILLIAM HARRAWAY OF LYDEWAY IN THE PARISH OF
URCHFONT, WILTSHIRE DATED 23 NOVEMBER 1769**

The will of Wm. Harraway

This Will was proved at Market Lavington Decr 7th 1781 before the Revd Thos Markes the Lawful Surrogate of the Revd and Worshipful William Whitworth Ch M.A. Archdeacon of the Archdry of Sarum and by him Account of the Effects of the said Testator was granted to Jane Harraway his Wido the Sole Extrix named therein being first Sworn to the truth of the said Will to perform the same and to Exhibit an Invtry & Acct when thereto Lawfully required

I William Harraway of Lydeway in the Parish of Urchfont in the County of Wilts Maltster and Victualler Do hereby make Publish and Declare this to be my last Will and Testament as follows (that is to say) First I give devise and bequeath all my Estate and Interest of and in All that Messuage Tenement or Dwelling house wherein I now dwell called or known by the name or Sign of the Bale with the Malthouse Outhouses Buildings Garden and other the Premises with the Appurtenances thereto belonging And also All my Stock of Beer and other Liquors Stock of Corn Cattle Implements of Husbandry and all other my Personall Estate and Stock whatsoever and wheresoever unto my good Friends Joseph Pierce of Urchfont aforesaid Maltster and Edward Pierce of Wedhampton in the said Parish of Urchfont Yeoman To hold unto them their Executors and Administrators for and during all the remainder of the Term that will be at my decease thereon to come Upon Trust that they my said Trustees their Executors or Administrators do permit and suffer my Wife Jane to hold and Enjoy the same and every part thereof for and forward Brooding up maintaining and Educating my son William Harraway until he shall Attain the age of Twenty one years and on his Attaining that age Then that my said Trustees do and shall equally divide the same to and between my said Wife and Son William Share and Share alike in Case my said Wife Shall so long Continue my Widow but if she shall intermarry before my said Son Shall Attain the said age of Twenty one years Then I give devise and bequeath the same Messuage Tenement or Dwelling house and other the Premises herein before mentioned and my said Stock of Beer and other Liquors Corn Cattle Implements of Husbandry and all other my said Estate and Effects whatsoever unto my said Trustees their Executors and Administrators Upon Trust that they do apply the same unto such Purposes as they shall think meet for the benefit of my Said Son William until he shall Attain the said Age of Twenty one years And immediately on his Attaining that Age I give devise and bequeath the same and every part thereof unto him my Said Son his Executors Administrators and Assigns (Except One Bed which I do hereby give unto my Said Wife in full of all her claim or Interest therein or thereby) And Lastly I do nominate and appoint my said Wife Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others at any time or times before by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Twenty third day of November in the Tenth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third by the grace of God King of Great Britain & p And in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and sixty nine.
